## **First Edition**

**Page 149 photo** the Red Rock Crab may be *Grapsus adscensionis* rather than *Pachygraphus marmoratus*.

**Page 183** Point 8. There has been some confusion about where the trail starts. This is right opposite the bar on the othat side of the road. The plants mentioned grow on the rocks here, both on the north and south-facing rocks.

Page 187 site C addition from one of our readers: the visitors' centre hands out free detailed maps of the National Park with all the marked trails.

Furthermore, the orchid site mentioned here is 800 metres south of the visitors' centre (not north as stated in the guide). Apart from Three-fingered Orchid, Two-leaved Genneria also occurs nearby, namely near the sign "El Tanquito" and then following the the road towards the low cliffs. Both Three-fingered Orchid and Two-leaved Genneria grow here in abundance.
