

## Crossbill Guide to Finnish Lapland including Kuusamo

### Wildflower list of Kilpisjärvi

The Kilpisjärvi area in the far northwest of Finland is botanically among the richest areas of the country. Along the way-marked trails, there are many wildflowers to be found. Here follows a list of our sightings in the area. Be aware that this list is not complete, nor are the frequency indications a reflection of proper surveys. Rather, they are born from our observations during the (inevitably limited) excursions in the area. This list could be seen as a trip report of the specific trails in this area. We provide it to complement the information given in the book for the routes and sites in the area.

Another thing to keep in mind is that some wildflowers common in Lapland, are rare or even absent from the trails of Kilpisjärvi. This can either be a matter of chance, or because of the much more arctic conditions here. The following list is clearly not a model for other areas in Lapland.

Lulledalen = the forested valley to the north of Kilpisjärvi, on the way to Skibotn

Nor-Malla = the Norwegian side of the Malla reserve
